Tour Begins in Guadalajara

DAY 1

After breakfast at the hotel we will be visiting the San Juan de Dios Market to learn about Mexico's National Sport "Charrería". At noon you will be attending a Mariachi Gala performance at the grand Teatro Degollado. Lunch today is on your own and during the afternoon we will visit the town of Tonalá to admire the artisans at the workshops making clay artifacts. Dinner at leisure tonight. (B)

DAY 4

Today, after breakfast, we are featuring a traditional "Calandria" (horse & buggy) ride through Guadalajara's Historical Center finishing in front of the Guadalajara Cathedral where Mariachi bands will be performing inside the Cathedral during the celebration of Mass. We'll gather for Lunch today at a local restaurant and evening/dinner at leisure. (B L)
